

Energy Wise[®] Programs Offer Great Savings

Join our Energy Wise family! MVEC's residential Energy Wise programs **offer lower electric rates and bill credits**. These programs emphasize our commitment to promoting wise and efficient use of electric energy. These programs apply to all electric* heating, cooling and water heating products.

Unmetered Air Conditioning Program

- Receive a 10% discount on all energy usage billed to the main meter on statements dated during June through September of every year.
- June through September your electric rate is \$.083/kWh and October through May your electric rate is \$.076/kWh.
- An energy management switch is installed at MVEC's expense. All other wiring is at the expense and is the responsibility of the member.
- The compressor cycles off and on (about 15 minutes each) during peak electric use periods (heavy demand times). This is not an every day occurrence. Typically, this is late afternoon through early evening on weekdays. The fan is not cycled off and on, only the compressor. The fan continues to circulate air in your home.
- Members with small businesses or more than one air conditioner will receive a \$9.00/month bill credit on statements dated during the months of June through September every year. Members must use a 200 kWh minimum each month to qualify for this bill credit.

Unmetered Electric Water Heating Program

- Receive an annual bill credit of \$72 on your electric bill (\$6.00/month).
- An energy management switch is installed at MVEC's expense. All other wiring is at the expense and is the responsibility of the member.
- Members must use a 200 kWh minimum each month to qualify for this bill credit.
- Control strategy: Interruptible - Unit controlled during heavy demand times through the energy management switch.

Metered Electric Heating Program

- Receive a \$.042/kWh rate.
- Open to all metered space and dual fuel* heating programs.
- Heat pump rate is \$.042/kWh October through June. July through September the heat pump rate is \$.059/kWh.
- All electric heating products are switched to your other heat source during heavy demand times.
- All wiring costs are the responsibility of the member. Installation is available through MVEC's network of local electricians. Installation costs vary.
- A wiring affidavit is required before MVEC can install a meter.

Metered Electric Water Heating Only Program

- Receive a \$.042/kWh rate year-round.
- Open to all metered* electric water heaters.
- Electric water heaters are separately metered from the rest of the household usage.
- Control strategy: Interruptible - Unit controlled during heavy demand times through the energy management switch.

Metered Combination Electric Heating & Cooling Program

- October through June your electric rate is \$.042/kWh and July through September your electric rate is \$.059/kWh.
- Open to all metered* electric water, space and dual fuel** heating programs in combination with an air conditioner or heat pump control.
- Also available for heat pumps on a stand-alone basis (not available to air conditioners as a stand-alone).
- All electric heating products (including electric water heaters) are controlled during heavy demand times.

*Any type of hard wired (permanent) electric heating system wired to an Energy Wise meter (heat pumps, baseboards, wall heaters, garage heaters, boilers, etc.) requires a wiring affidavit before MVEC can install a meter.

** Dual fuel offers two sources of heat with electricity being the primary heat source.

Wiring

All wiring must be completed by the owner or an electrician and must be inspected by a local or state inspector before MVEC can make an appointment to install the meter. MVEC offers a listing of local contractors who are familiar with our programs on our web site at www.mvec.net.
